Our first round matches for both the netball and football competitions will take place at 2pm on Thursday 16th January at Hunsdon Primary School. Spectators are welcome at these matches.

School Games Mark:

As you are aware, Morgans achieved the School Games Platinum Award this summer for their commitment to PE and Sport. As a school, we have to monitor our Year 3-6 participation rates in school clubs as well as Year 3-6 participation rates in sporting competitions. Here are our Participation rates for this Autumn Term:

Year 3:

- Number of children in clubs = $26/54 = 48\%$
- Number of children represented the school = $29/54 = 54\%$

Year 4:

- Number of children in clubs = $28/57 = 49\%$
- Number of children represented the school = $32/57 = 56\%$

Year 5:

- Number of children in clubs = $51/88 = 58\%$
- Number of children represented the school = $28/88 = 32\%$

Year 6:

- Number of children in clubs = $43/60 = 72\%$
- Number of children represented the school = $42/60 = 70\%$

The total number of year 3-6 children:

- Number of children in clubs = $148/259 = 57\%$
- Number of children represented the school = $131/259 = 51\%$

This has been a fantastic start to the school year and we will continue to build on these opportunities to provide as many children as possible the chance to represent the school in a sporting event.
